The job responsibilities includes SAP design, configuration, testing, developing training material, training, conversion, go live and ongoing user support. Extensive (50% - 75%) travel may be needed depending on project location and phase.

Essential Responsibilities:

Project Team and Enterprise Interaction: Work with other project team members and appropriate business departments to identify appropriate business solutions and resolve specific issues for SAP implementations.

Documentation and Communication: Utilize standard SAP Program documentation, reports and communication as appropriate to project role. Create specific documentation or reports as appropriate to project being implemented. Communicate with other IT, Competency Center and business groups as required.

Testing and Configuration: Be responsible for testing and configuration of SAP for a specific project and business or IT function. This will be process functionality for existing business analysts, or data conversion/interfaces if an IT Programmer/Analyst.
